4. Activities of SCMI AICS Unit 2018-2019

4.1. Sending Delegates: As we receive an invitation from the Regional Secretary, North-East Zone, to attend the SCMI North-East Regional Camp at Dimapur on 6th- 9th May, 2018. The SCMI AICS Unit sent three delegates, K. Lalhriatpuia (President, SCMI AICS Unit), V. Zonunsanga and PC Liandingpuia to attend the Regional Camp.

4.2. Fasting Prayer: Fasting prayer is organised every Wednesday evening except during examinations. Anyone who attends this prayer service can pray in their own dialect. It is meant for spiritual renewal and heartfelt interaction with God. Offerings are collected in this prayer service which is solely kept aside for helping people who are in need.

4.3. Blood Donation Camp: SCMI AICS Unit organised Blood Donation Camp in the campus on 30th October 2018 for the blood bank of Civil Hospital Aizawl. 53 units of blood were donated at this camp.

4.4. Inter-Cultural worship: SCMI AICS Unit organised Inter-cultural worship on 24th February 2019, Sunday at Pastor Thanzinga Chapel with the theme “Unity in Diversity”. As it is a special worship service, the community members and students were encouraged to wear their own traditional attire if possible. There was a display of various cultures with their own traditional attire, cultural dance, cultural song from the AICS Choir and a speech on the theme from the Principal, Rev. Prof. R. Zolawma.

4.5. SCMI Nite: SCMI Nite was organised on 24th February 2019 night at Pastor Thanzinga Chapel. Here, two guests artists Vanlalsailova and Hlondo Sisters were invited to sing and enrich the programme. Also The Purpose Dance Crew and Davida Perkhkuang were invited to perform on this night. SCMI members from sister college like Aizawl Theological College and Mizoram Bible College were invited along with the Evangelical Union of Mizoram University.

4.6. Social Service: SCMI AICS Unit organised Social Service on 15th August 2018 in which Tanhril area where AICS resides was cleaned. This Social Service

includes, cleaning the roadside and cutting grasses, erecting hoarding which says “In Kawngte chu chhut ngun rawh u” / “Consider how you have fared” – Haggai 1:5.

4.7 Charity: In collaboration with the Worship and Music Committee of AICS, SCMI AICS Unit could help 7 families in and around Tanhrial locality by giving Charity as a Christmas gift. This money is from the offerings that are collected from Fasting Prayer.

4.8. Awarding students who read through the Bible: SCMI AICS Unit also gave award to those who ever read through the Bible within the academic session 2018-2019.

5. Fund Raising:

5.1. SCMI Fun Fair: As a part of AICS Day Celebration and a means to raise fund for SCMI AICS Unit, SCMI Fun Fare was organised on 18th October 2018 in the campus with the special Chief Guest, Rev. Dr vanlalchhawna Khiangte, Vice Principal of AICS. All the community members as well as student from AICS Junior School were participating on this day.

5.2. T-Shirt and Key-chain: SCMI AICS Unit also prepare T-shirt for the students and community members for fund raising. Also key-chain where SCMI logo was pasted was made and sold it in the community.

5.3. Selling Books: SCMI AICS Unit is fortunate enough to receive an opportunity of selling 2 books authored by Rev. VL Nithanga and Upa N. Kilsaia.

5.4. AICS Calendar: The Unit also published AICS Calendar 2019 where 1000 copies were made approximately. These copies were given to students to sell it during their Winter vacation.

5.5 Projecting World Cup Final match: SCMI AICS Unit organised a big-screen projected World Cup Final Match for raising funds in the Dining Hall. It was observed as successful as many of the students and community members bought the entry ticket. Some edible items were sold out on this night.
